ORDER OF KINGSHIP

1. Kings inherit kingship by birthright

- 2. Kings must be trained for their roles and responsibilities.
- 3. The glory of a king is all that express his nature.
- 4. The word of a king is law in his kingdom territory.
- 5. The power of a king is absolute.
- 6. A king's authority is inherited in his sovereignty (in-born).
- 7. The decree of a king is unchangeable.
- 8. The home of a king expresses his standards (You bring it value)
- 9. The reputation of a king is determined by the state and conditioning of his kingdom citizens. (Freedom is confused with independence; freedom is not equal to independence).

Sin is the declaration of dependence from God, not on God. Worship puts pressure on God's reputation (name-sake). His name is represented by your state of living (to depend is to trust). The less you depend on God the more you have to do for yourself. Your dependence is His glory.
