
Nearly 2 Million Vaccine Doses in NJ and Rent Relief

Nearly 2 MILLION VACCINE DOSES IN NEW JERSEY



Nearly 2 million doses of COVID-19 vaccine have been administered to New Jerseyans, as the chart above shows.

Eligibility for vaccine in New Jersey continues to be limited to persons 65 and older and younger adults with underlying health conditions. To get vaccinated, all residents must sign up on the state website, covidvaccine.nj.gov, so you can be notified when you become eligible. You can also call the New Jersey Call Center Vaccination Support Number between 8 AM and 8 PM: 855-568-0545.

Those who are eligible may also sign up for hospital-based, public, and private sites offering vaccination, such as CVS, and the several New Jersey "Mega Sites." All are experiencing demand in excess of supply, so you may need to try multiple times.
